Rainbow Childcare aims to provide flexible, quality childcare at an affordable price. As you will see from the next page our prices represent excellent value for a high quality service.

Our childcare aims to be as flexible as possible with a mixture of sessions available. For the Preschool Childcare children may supplement their place in the school nursery class by attending before school, during the morning, over lunch time or for the afternoon. We also provide childcare for those younger preschoolers from 2 years upwards who have not yet started school nursery, including those on the two year offer funding currently available.

During school term time the Out of School Club children may attend before school or after school, whilst during school holidays there is a morning and afternoon session, or children may of course be in for the full day.

We will aim to encourage each child to achieve their full potential, growing in confidence, being sociable and independent. We will also ensure staff are sensitive and responsive to all the individual needs of each child and build up a caring partnership with all parents and their children.

NB:

- 1) All charges are correct at September 2023 and will be reviewed annually.
- 2) A discount of 10% will be deducted for second and subsequent children from the same family.
- 3) Additional charges may be made for extra activities such as trips during school holidays.
- 4) Unless prior arrangement has been made, all fees must be paid either weekly or monthly in advance, either by cash, cheque, bank transfer or childcare voucher.
- 5) One week's notice is required if changes to booked places are required.

11.45am Lunch time (packed lunch from home).

12.15pm Take afternoon children to Nursery Class.

1.00pm Activities similar to those provided each morning.

3.00pm Close of Session.

Other things you need to know

School collection

Where appropriate your child will be escorted to and from the designated place in Millbrook and St Michael & All Angels' Schools. Please note that it is very important that you inform the school and us if your child will be attending Rainbow Childcare.

Admission

Places are allocated on a first come first served basis and all children are welcome if there is an available place.

Cancellation

All childcare places must be booked in advance. When requirements change we need you to give us as much notice as possible. All cancellations giving less than seven days notice will be charged in full.

In case of sickness

If your child is unwell it is imperative that you contact us as soon as possible. Likewise if your child is unable to participate in the activities provided or is infectious because of ill health we will contact you.

Collection at the end of the session

Please make every effort to collect your child before the end of the session as the school closes at 6.00pm. Where this may become impossible due to unforeseen circumstances please notify Rainbow Childcare immediately. Where a delay occurs past 6.00pm Rainbow Childcare reserves the right to make a surcharge of £5 per child per 15-minute period that should be paid to the staff at the time of collection.

Food and drink

Where appropriate your child will be provided with a light breakfast or a mid morning / afternoon snack. Where your child is staying over lunchtime a packed lunch must be provided from home. Any allergies or dietary requests will be adhered to.

Duty of Care

The welfare and well being of all the children in our care is paramount. This means that we have a duty to the children, parents/carers and staff to act quickly and responsibly, reporting any suspicions of abuse to the Local Safeguarding Children Board. Rainbow Childcare will follow their procedures, and will seek their advice on all steps taken subsequently.

Parental involvement

We welcome your interest and involvement in Rainbow Childcare and will aim to keep you informed of your child's progress and development.

Unacceptable behaviour

Rainbow Childcare expects a good standard of behaviour from all the children in its care. If a child's behaviour falls below what is expected then we will talk to parents with a view of forming a joint strategy to deal with this behaviour. In the unlikely event that a child's behaviour consistently falls short and becomes a danger to themselves, other children or the Rainbow staff we reserve the right to terminate the child's place.

Data protection

Please note: we will only use your personal information in relation to our childcare service. We keep your information so you can receive important updates about our Nursery. We will keep your information secure and will never share it except if required to do so by law.
